Master Plan progress and urgent appeal for help

Disappointingly, although we now have full agreement over the majority of the plan, we are still in negotiation with the Council over the future of the north west corner - Clancarty Lodge and the depot. The Friends committee is planning to put the full situation before an open meeting scheduled for Monday, 29th of November at Thomas's School in Hugon Road - or possibly earlier - keep a look out !

Childrens' Play Area

The landscape architects have been authorised to begin work and we're hoping to have design options developed in the next 8-10 weeks for community review.

Portaloos

The temporary toilets which were installed for the summer season have had to be removed, now that there are no bookable sports activities other than tennis.

New signage

A very prolonged design and consultation process to provide new signage in all parks and open spaces across the Borough is at last nearing completion. In South Park there will again be signs at all entrances and a bye-laws notice. Installation is scheduled for completion by the end of October and removal of all the old signs across the Borough will follow. The new signage in our childrens' play area is already in place.
